QRM: Recasting the Time Factor in Lean Planning for Better Performance

**Thursday, May 16th
Geneva, IL**

Speaker: Kent Vincent, CIRM

Quick Response Manufacturing (QRM) highlights the benefits of reducing internal and external lead times. Shorter lead times eliminate non-value-added waste, improve quality, and reduce cost within an organization. QRM facilitates this while simultaneously increasing the organization's competitiveness and market share through better customer service. QRM is a time based framework that accommodates strategic variability such as offering custom-engineered products while eliminating variation such as rework and changing due dates. Companies making products in low or varying volumes have used QRM as an alternative or to complement other strategies such as Lean Manufacturing, Total quality management, Six Sigma or Kaizen.

QRM extends basic principles of time-based competition while including these new aspects:

- Singular focus on lead time reduction
- Clarification of the misconceptions managers have about how to apply time-based strategies

- Companywide approach reaching beyond shop floor to other areas such as office operations and the supply chain

- Use of cellular organization structure throughout the business with more holistic and flexible cells

- Inclusion of basic principles of systems dynamics to provide insight on how to best reorganize an enterprise to achieve quick response

- New material planning and control approach (POLCA)

- Specific QRM principles on how to rethink manufacturing process and equipment decisions

- Focus on implementation and sustainability

- Manufacturing Critical-path Time (MCT) metric to measure lead times

Kent Vincent, MS, MBA, Six Sigma Black Belt, APICS CIRM has served as a manufacturing and systems consultant to clients in the food, packaging, metal finishing, chemical, and automotive, instrumentation, and natural mineral and biomaterial industries for over 20 years. As an experienced process chemist and food and polymer product development engineer, he gained expertise in the areas of process control and supply chain optimization, production and laboratory systems design, materials handling and testing, shop floor data handling, and process modeling.

His background contains a mix of technical expertise and practical management experience. Following a career with industry leaders IBM, Getty Oil and Beatrice Foods in large

Update from the President

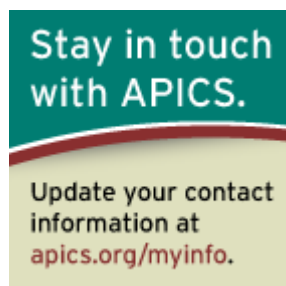
